#### 3 bags Chester's butter puffed corn

- 2 sticks unsalted butter
- 2 cups brown sugar
- 1/2 cup light Karo syrup
- 1 teaspoon salt
- 1 teaspoon vanilla
- 1/2 teaspoon baking soda

#### Miss Nancy's Caramel Popcorn

Add butter, brown sugar, Karo syrup and salt in a boiler. Bring to a boil stirring constantly. Turn down to a slow boil and boil for 5 minutes <u>without stirring</u>. Divide puffed corn into 2 large disposable aluminum roasting pans. Remove mixture from heat and add 1 tsp. vanilla, stir, then add 1/2 tsp. baking soda, stir. Pour 1/2 of the mixture over each pan of puffed corn and stir. Bake at 250\* for 1 hour stirring every 15 minutes. Let cool and store in airtight containers or baggies.
