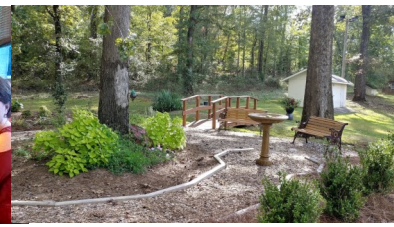













Alabama CBF Fall Gathering
