From The Front Porch

The most easily overlooked part of this routine was the team meeting. But, it actually might have been the most important because it was the time to be sure everyone was on the same page regarding the game plan and it gave the coaches one last opportunity to rally the team.

Our church business meetings are part of our church routine and rhythm. There has been a slight change in this routine. In our last business meeting in June, the Deacons recommended having church business meetings on a quarterly, instead of monthly, basis. First of all, when having church business meetings on a monthly basis, there were times when the only item of business was the financial report. Secondly, church business meetings on a guarterly basis will ensure that each committee has an opportunity to meet between business meetings and then report on their respective area of ministry during each business meeting.

Thirdly, we hope that on a guarterly basis more church members will be able to attend the church business meetings. hope you will make it a point to stay for these meetings because, though they can easily be overlooked, they are an important part of our church routine and rhythm. They give us an opportunity to all be on the same page in regard to the ministries of our church and hear stories about God's ministry taking place through our church. In other words, these meetings are an opportunity to be rallied together around what God is doing at Alpine Baptist Church!
