Ash Wednesday, February 22, is the first day in the season of Lent. Lent is the forty-day season in the church calendar that comes before Easter. Lent is not observed by all Baptist churches. The church I grew up attending may have mentioned it once or twice, but it did not hold a place of prominence in the life of the church or in my own spiritual life.

The first Ash Wednesday service I attended was during my first year in seminary at Harris Creek Baptist Church. That was also the first year I observed the common Lenten practice of giving up something during the season of Lent. Another common practice during Lent is to take on another spiritual practice.

This Sunday there will be many Lenten devotionals by Christian writer, Kate Bowler, available for you to take. Kate Bowler has written several books over the past few years. Most popular is her bestseller, *Everything Happens for a Reason: And Other Lies I've Loved,* which she wrote after being diagnosed with an aggressive form of cancer at the age of 35. For this Lenten season, she wrote a free devotional booklet titled, *Bless the Lent We Actually Have.* In the preface, she writes the following:

"Lent is our annual rehearsal of the cosmic moment when Jesus' suffering and death and resurrection will change how we experience death. Death will not be the defining truth about us. Someday we will be freed from the gorgeous and horrible limitations of our human lives, and we will live forever with God (which is VERY DIFFICULT FOR ME TO IMAGINE. But it's the truth.). But first Jesus suffers and dies. We walk with him. And he walks with us. Jesus will walk with us through whatever kind of Lenten day you are having. The lovely one. The garbage one. The one that barely seems like it counted at all. As we toggle through every kind of emotion—boredom, devastation, happiness, irritation—we want to say: bless this Lent."

I hope you'll pick up a devotional this Sunday, read it as your Lenten practice, and be blessed by the One that walks with us through every day and forevermore.
